Once again, “Blockupy Frankfurt” calls for European days of protest in Frankfurt am Main against the crisis regime of the European Union May 31<sup>st</sup>/June 1<sup>st</sup>. Again, we'll take the resistance against the policy of the German government and the Troika — consisting of ECB, EU-Commission and IMF — into one of the centers of European crisis management: to the residence of the European Central Bank (ECB) and of many German banks and corporations — the profiteers of these policies.

We want you to join us — all the various people, movements, organizations from from all over Europe and be part of the action days in Frankfurt. We are convinced we need to follow up on last year's days of action since new proposals — so called “reforms” — for the cuts in social welfare and the pressure of the austerity measures driven by European institutions and especially the German government have further increased in recent months. A strong European voice from below, a progressive and emancipatory force from all over Europe is what we need and work for.

At Blockupy 2012, we already were together in the streets. On November 14<sup>th</sup> we coordinated our actions in support of the first pan-european strike. In Brussels we assemble again, joined in our desire for another Europe. At Blockupy 2013 we will take the streets, block the banks and institutions responsible for austerity and won't be afraid of confronting the state powers. We'll continue our exchange and networking on international meetings such as the Alter Summit in Athens.

On Friday, May 31, many initiatives will engage in diverse creative actions with the aim to block the ECB. On Saturday, June 1, a huge demonstration will take place in the city center of Frankfurt.
